

Important Changes from V6

The first and most important change is that the software now runs on the 'live' database and has no reliance on the reporting database. This means all additions and reports are in real time so that if you vaccinate someone and then run the vaccination report their name will appear immediately.

Another change is that all vaccination information is now stored in a separate Combined Vaccination database which also holds details of all batches of all types of vaccinations.

Opening an eligible patient record will show there have been some changes to the screen:
